Indian shares rose for a sixth straight session on Friday to a 11-week high as foreign investors continued to buy local stocks on indication of a policy shift towards reviving growth, with an increase in global risk appetite also aiding sentiment. The benchmark has added about 11 percent so far this year. It had shed nearly a quarter last year, making it one of the worst performers in the world.

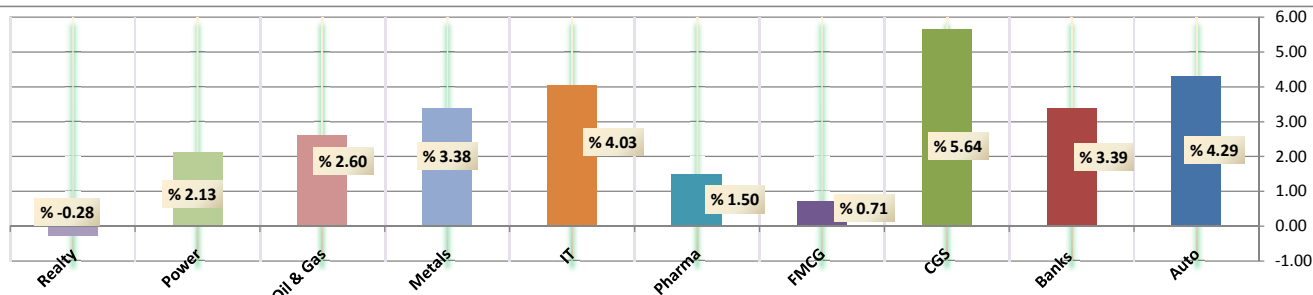
Hong Kong shares ended higher for a sixth-straight session on Friday, though profit-taking capped gains after a January rally that has boosted the benchmark Hang Seng Index by more than 11 percent. Tokyo's Nikkei closed down 0.09%, bringing its weekly gain to 0.85%.

Britain's top shares fell on Friday as U.S. growth data missed expectations and came with a warning of speed bumps ahead for the world's biggest economy, heaping pressure on mining and integrated oil stocks.

A disappointing quarterly report from Chevron and a lower-than-expected US economic growth report for the fourth quarter kept a lid on US markets Friday. The Dow and S&P fell 0.45% and 0.08% for their first weekly drops in four weeks. The Nasdaq was up 1.07% on the week, stretching its winning streak to four weeks.

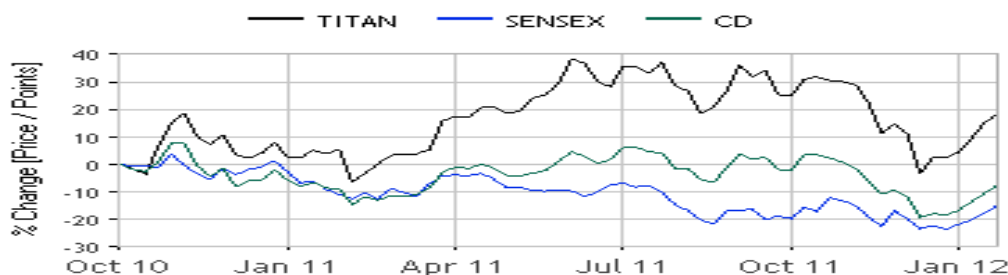
